- Overnight: Jerusalem






Day 3 – Wednesday, May 13 Solidarity in the South

Day 6 – Saturday, May 16 Shabbat in Tel Aviv


- Optional guided walk through Neve Tzedek and Nachalat Binyamin – art & architecture highlights
